



## Middle School Learning Support Services Registration for 2023-2024

If your child has a diagnosis that affects their learning, such as a learning difference, mood disorder, or ADHD, he/she is eligible for our Learning Support Services Program. Once your child is enrolled in this program, we are able to provide the following support for your child:

- A confidential Student Education Plan will be given to your child's teachers outlining your child's diagnosis and recommended accommodations. Please communicate with your child's teachers and/or the LSS counselor about specific accommodation needs.
- On-campus tutoring at cost- Students may use flex time or are allowed to miss half of their PE/Arts elective period to work with a tutor during the school day if needed. They may also have tutoring before or after school.
- The support of two counselors, the Middle School Counselor and the Learning Support Services Coordinator, for your child, for you and for the teachers.
