



Dear Parents:

The math department is offering summer work in order to aid in your child's success going forward in the math curriculum here at Episcopal. This option, ALEKS, is an online, adaptive program that can be tailored to review those skills most critical to success in next year's course. In addition, because of the adaptive nature of the program, the program tailors itself to each individual student's needs, allowing them to move on from topics mastered and giving them more help on those topics not yet mastered. While this work is not required, we strongly encourage it as a form of skill building to prepare for next year. The intent is that your child will have a chance to solidify skills not mastered this year or in previous courses so that they will have a better foundation for next year.

Progress for Middle School students will be monitored by Nancy Callaway, and progress for Upper School students will be monitored by the Math Department Chair, Stephen Anderson. Updates will be sent as needed throughout the summer via email to students and parents. The course will remain active for three calendar months from the start date.

The cost of this program is \$50, and you will be billed through Episcopal. Please let me know if you have any questions.
