Episcopal School of Baton Rouge is seeking an energetic, creative early childhood teacher. The position is full-time. A bachelor's degree is required with at least four years of teaching experience. A degree in early childhood education is preferred, but a candidate with a passion for young children would be considered. A successful candidate understands the importance of nurturing social-emotional development in young children, juggles many responsibilities and is adaptable to change, maintains control of their classroom and takes charge of a situation, and develops a classroom environment where purposeful play and outdoor exploration are nurtured. Familiarity with the principals of Responsive Classroom is a plus.

Episcopal faculty members serve as representatives of the school at all times, upholding the school's mission both personally and professionally. A candidate must be a self-motivated individual with excellent communication skills who works well with others and has an eagerness to help each student achieve his or her full potential. Experience with technology is desired but a strong willingness to learn how to integrate technology will be considered. An unwavering professional demeanor is expected, and the skill to develop strong parental relationships is a must. Being a person that self-identifies (and that others describe) as a "happy" person, an emotionally intelligent person, a person with natural "situational awareness," a person who consistently strives to improve, a "forward-looking" person, and a person who "plays well with others," are all characteristics of the successful candidate.
