



Middle School Learning Support Services Registration for 2019-2020

If your child has a diagnosis that affects their learning, such as a learning disability or ADHD, he/she is eligible for our Learning Support Services Program. Once your child is enrolled in this program, we are able to provide the following support for your child:

- A Student Education Plan will be given to your child's teachers outlining your child's diagnosis and recommended accommodations. Please communicate with your child's teachers and/or the LSS counselor about specific accommodation needs. Students may begin the year with minimal accommodations, and we intervene when we notice students needing extra support.
- On-campus tutoring – In middle school, students may miss PE and/or arts class once a week for tutoring if they are enrolled in the program. They may also use flex and after school time for tutoring.
- The learning support services counselor, Robin Talamo, is available to provide support for your child, for you and for the teachers.
