It is the student's responsibility to notify the office immediately if there is a change in license plate or vehicle.

Conditions for permit:

Driving:

- A. Student will be required to abide by all driving regulations as set forth by the State of Louisiana Motor Vehicle Office.
- B. Student will abide by all driving regulations set forth by Episcopal both on campus and in the subdivision especially abiding by the posted **speed limits of 10 miles per hour on campus, 20 miles per hour in the school zone, and 30 miles per hour on the Boulevard, outside of the school zone.**
- C. Episcopal is absolved from any responsibility to the driver, riders and the vehicle while in transit to and from Episcopal or while on school property.
- D. Students must have permission from the Dean of Students to go into the parking areas during the school day.
- E. Episcopal student regulations will be in effect for all drivers and riders while on campus regardless of time.
- F. Only the registered driver may drive the vehicle on and off campus.

Parking:

- A. Students must park in the assigned parking spot or area and must display their assigned parking tag.
- B. Student may not loan, sell, or assign their parking spot to anyone else.
- C. Students parked in a space or area to which they are not assigned will receive a detention upon the first infraction, with loss of parking should the pattern persist.
- D. A student that accumulates multiple unexcused absences or reports of tardy may lose parking privileges without reimbursement.
- E. Parking is permitted only in designated areas. Parking in areas not approved including, but not limited to, handicapped and visitor spaces can result in receiving city/ parish police traffic tickets or vehicle towing.
- F. You may not move your vehicle at the end of the school day if you are remaining on campus for an extracurricular activity. It must remain in your assigned space. This is due to safety concerns and space issues.

Violation of any of the above regulations will be sufficient cause to terminate driving privileges temporarily or permanently.

There will be a \$10 replacement fee for any lost tags.
