

Lower School Learning Support Services Registration for 2024-2025

If your child has a diagnosis that affects their learning, such as a learning disability or ADHD, he/she is eligible for our Learning Support Services Program. Once your child is enrolled in this program, we are able to provide the following types of support for your child:

- A confidential Student Education Plan (SEP) will be given to your child's teachers outlining the diagnosis and recommended accommodations. Please communicate with your child's teachers and/ or the LSS counselor about specific accommodation needs. Students may begin the year with minimal accommodations, and we can intervene and modify as needed for additional support.
- Optional On-campus tutoring In lower school, students may miss PE and/or art class once a week for tutoring if they are enrolled in the program. They may also use homeroom time and after school time for tutoring.
- The learning support services counselor and Lower School Counselor are available to provide support for your child, for parents, and for the teachers.
